**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
SOUTH DADE MINORITY CULTURAL ARTS TASK FORCE INC.**

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SECRETARY OF STATE  
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, desiring to form a charitable corporation under the Not-For Profit Corporation Law, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes hereby certifies:

**NAME**

- I. The name of the corporation shall be South Dade Minority Cultural Arts Task Force, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation". )

**DURATION**

- II. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

**LOCATION**

- III. The principal office of the Corporation shall be located at 14842 Robinson Street, Miami, Florida 33176 in Miami-Dade County. The Registered Agent's address is 14842 Robinson Street, Miami, Florida 33176 in Miami-Dade County.

**PURPOSE**

- IV. The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and cultural arts purposes, inclusive of but without limitation therein:
- a. linking Miami-Dade County's multi-ethnic communities by building a strong bridge through the Cultural Arts.
  - b. enhancing the cultural awareness level of culturally deprived residents of Miami-Dade County by providing cultural arts program
  - c. enhancing the degree of education of Miami-Dade County residents through the use of Cultural Arts Programs.
  - d. developing respect for values and cultural diversity of all Miami-Dade County residents.

**POWERS**

- V. In furtherance, but not in limitation, of the foregoing charitable, educational and cultural arts purposes, the corporation shall have the powers:

- a. To receive gifts, bequests and contributions in any form;
- b. To solicit, collect and receive money and other assets;
- c. To administer funds and contribute, use, sell or otherwise dispose of any money, securities, property, rights or services acquired;
- d. To borrow money and to make, accept, endorse, execute and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, and other corporate obligations, for money borrowed; and
- f. To exercise all other rights and powers conferred upon corporations formed under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act.

#### MEMBERSHIP

VI. The membership of the Corporation shall be concerned residents of Miami-Dade County who demonstrate an interest in cultural arts. The method of electing directors shall be set forth in By laws of the Corporation.

#### BOARD OF DIRECTORS

VII. The following persons shall serve the Corporation as directors until the first annual meeting:

#### INCOME DISTRIBUTION

VIII. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or private individuals, but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay

reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article "FIVE" hereof. It is intended that this Corporation shall have and continue to have the status of a Corporation which is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (hereinafter, the "Code"), as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and which is other than a private foundation by reason of being described in Section 509(a)(1), (2) or (3) of the Code. These Articles shall be constructed accordingly, and all powers and activities of the Corporation shall be limited accordingly. The Corporation shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation to such extent as would result in the loss of its exemption from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. No activity of the Corporation shall consist of participating in or intervening in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS AFTER DISSOLUTION

IX. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for charitable, educational or cultural purposes to such "qualified" organization or organizations as the Board of Trustees shall determine. An organization shall be deemed to be a "qualified" organization for purposes of this Article "NINE" only if at the time of the distribution of such assets it is organized and operated exclusively for the purposes described in Section 170(c)(2)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code and as described in Section 509(a)(1), (2) or (3) of said Code. Any of such assets not so distributed

shall be distributed by the Circuit Court of Dade County, exclusively for the aforesaid purposes of the Corporation or to such qualified organization or organizations as said court shall determine.

#### INDEMNITY

X. The Corporation may indemnify, to the full extent permitted by law, any and all persons who may serve, or who have served at any time, as director or officer, and their respective heirs, administrators, successors and assigns, against any and all expenses, including, but not limited to amounts paid upon judgments, counsel fees and amounts paid in settlement of any claim, action, suit or proceeding, by reason of having been or being directors or officers; provided that the Corporation shall provide no indemnification in cases wherein the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance in the performance of his or her duties. The indemnification herein described may be entitled under any law, by-law agreement, vote to active members, or otherwise.

#### AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

XI. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members at a meeting of members at which a quorum is present shall be required for the approval and adoption of any amendment of these Articles of Incorporation and any resolution or dissolution of the Corporation.

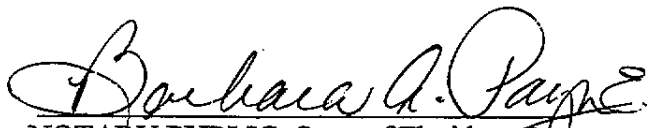

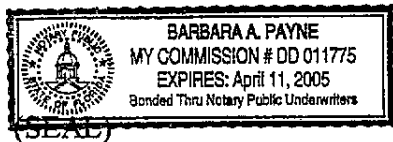
