

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

to

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

H.Y.P.E. Outreach Career Education Center, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617,1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Orlando Seventh Day Baptist Church, Inc.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE OF THE CORPORATION

The corporation is organized as a church exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes: the establishing and maintaining of religious worship, the evangelizing of the unsaved by the proclaiming of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, the educating of believers in a manner consistent with the requirements of Holy Scripture, either in Sabbath and weekday schools of Christian education or in theological seminary, the maintaining of missionary activities in the United States and any foreign country, and any other lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit and not specifically prohibited to corporations under other laws of the state of Florida.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was November 2, 2002.

THIRD: The amendment was adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
