adopts the following articles.

ARTICLE VIII

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributed to it's members, trustees, officers or other private persons. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in the publishing or distribution of statements for any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (A) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(C)(3) of the internal revenue code or the corresponding section of any future tax code or (B) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(C)(2) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code.

ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the internal revenue code. Or the corresponding section of any future income tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction or the county of which the principal office is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine which are organized or operated exclusively for such purposes.
