AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, (Not for Profit), the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts and substitutes these Amended Articles of Incorporation for the Articles of Incorporation previously filed.

ARTICLES I

The name of the corporation shall be: JOYWA, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

Mailing Address: P.O. Box 12088 Ft. Pierce, FL 34979

ARTICLE III

The corporation is created to provide support or assistance to young people suffering from AIDS in the island of Jamaica, West Indies. In an effort to achieve those means, the corporation is authorized to carry out any legal act or business venture and shall develop methods for the distribution of such funds, services or other benefits.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) and political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE V

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent

Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI

The directors of the corporation are as listed below and are subject to change from time to time at the direction of the membership. Any vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be appointed by a majority vote of the remaining board members.
