Pursuant to the provisions of sections 607.0124 and 617.0124, Florida Statutes, CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. adopts the following Articles of Correction to its Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST: The Articles of Incorporation for CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. which were filed on December 11, 2001 and assigned document number N01000008648, a copy of which are attached, have been filed containing "incorrect statements," and shall be corrected as prescribed herein.

SECOND: The "incorrect statements" which necessitate these ARTICLES OF CORRECTION are contained within ARTICLE THREE, ARTICLE FOUR, and ARTICLE FIVE of the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION are construed as incorrect because they do not concur with the current draft of the Corporate Bylaws, and shall be corrected as follows.

As corrected, ARTICLE THREE shall now appear as follows:

ARTICLE THREE

- 3.1. The Five-Fold Purpose of the Church of Jesus Christ.** The purpose of the Church of Jesus Christ is to glorify God by living the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:36-40) and fulfilling the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) in accordance with the following biblical principles:
- 3.1.1 **WORSHIP** - To participate in public worship services together and to maintain personal daily devotions. (John 4:24)
 - 3.1.2 **EVANGELISM** - To share the good news of Jesus Christ with as many people as possible in our community and throughout the world using all available resources and technology. (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; 2 Peter 3:9)
 - 3.1.3 **MINISTRY/MISSIONS** - To serve unselfishly in Jesus' name, meeting the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of those in our Church, community and in the world. (1 Peter 4:10-11; Matthew 25:34-40; 1 Thessalonians 5:11; Galatians 5:13)
 - 3.1.4 **DISCIPLESHIP** - To help attendees develop toward full Christian maturity and train them for effective ministry. To promote personal, spiritual growth and discipleship through Bible teaching. (Ephesians 4:11-13; Matthew 18:20; 2 Timothy 2:1,2)
 - 3.1.5 **FELLOWSHIP** - To encourage, support and pray for each other as members of the family of God. To share our lives together. (1 John 1:7; Acts 2:44-47; Hebrews 10:23-25; Romans 15:5-7; John 13:34,35)

CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. seeks to benefit everyone in greater Charlotte County by providing opportunities for spiritual, physical, intellectual, social and cultural development. (Luke 2:52)

- 3.2. **The Mission of Christ Life Community Church, Inc.** Becoming a blessing to our Community and the World as we endeavor to turn unchurched people into devoted followers of Jesus Christ is the mission of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC.
- 3.3. **The Vision of Christ Life Community Church, Inc.** The vision is ignited by a sincere concern for people; creating an exciting, aesthetically appropriate environment, enhanced by an excellent expression of the arts and contemporary communication that is rooted in Scripture. It effectively relates to current issues requiring Christ's solutions, which provide hope, trust, and love. Interaction with God will be the response to their new life, which our Mission initiates. They will be nurtured and disciplined as a result of small group leadership in the community of believers. Each person will discover and implement their gift and style, pursuing their passion, which will enable them to make a meaningful contribution in serving people and expanding God's kingdom.

As corrected, ARTICLE FOUR shall now appear as follows:

ARTICLE FOUR

- 4.1. The biblical Government of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. and the legislation of its affairs shall be vested in a Congress, comprised of its Membership and Board of Directors, and shall be executed by the President of the Corporation. The Board of Directors (pursuant to Section 617.0801, Florida Statutes) shall be nominated by the President and elected to a two-year term by the Members of the Corporation in a Regular Annual Session of the Membership, held on the first Monday of June in each year or at such other times as the President may choose. The Board of Directors together with the President shall exercise all powers of the Corporation except those which are conferred upon other Judiciary or Fiduciary entities within the Corporation or are reserved by law, the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, or the Bylaws to the Members of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. The Board of Directors shall be comprised of as few as five (5) or as many as eleven (11) Members in good standing of the Corporation (not including the President).
- 4.2. The President ex-officio of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. shall continue in Office while he holds the title of "Senior Pastor," shall be construed as a non-voting Director, and shall be conferred the exclusive right to appoint one Executive Vice President and as many Vice Presidents, not to serve as Directors, but to serve as Executive Appointees, as he shall deem beneficial. One Clerk shall be appointed by the Board of Directors to keep Journals for Sessions of both Members and Directors.
- 4.3. The Treasurer of the Corporation shall not be a Director or Executive Appointee, but shall be a Member in good standing of the Corporation, and shall be appointed by the President and confirmed by the Board of Directors alone or in concurrence with another Judiciary or Fiduciary entity within the Corporation.

As corrected, ARTICLE FIVE shall now appear as follows:

ARTICLE FIVE

- 5.1. The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is seven (7) and the names and addresses of the Persons who are to serve as the initial Directors are as follows:

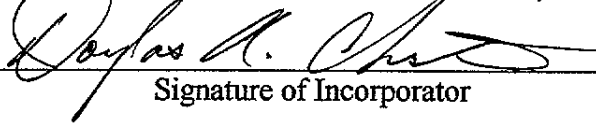

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC., and shall be referred to hereinafter as the Church or the Corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. is to glorify God by fulfilling the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:36-40) and the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) in accordance with the following biblical principles:

WORSHIP - To participate in public worship services together and to maintain personal daily devotions. (John 4:24)

ARTICLE FOUR

The Government of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. and the management of its affairs shall be vested in the Board of Directors (pursuant to Section 617.0801, Florida Statutes), nominated by the Senior Pastor and elected by the qualified voting members of the Corporation at an annual meeting of the members held on the 1st Monday of June in each year or at such other times as the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") may choose. The Board shall exercise all powers of the Corporation except those which are conferred upon the Senior Pastor or reserved by law, the Articles of Incorporation, or the Bylaws to the Voting Membership of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. The Board of Directors shall be comprised of eleven voting Members in good standing (including the Senior Pastor).

The Senior Pastor of CHRIST LIFE COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC. shall ipso facto serve as the President of the Board, and the Board shall elect from their own number or otherwise Vice Presidents, a Corporate Secretary, and a Treasurer and such other officers as they may from time to time deem expedient.

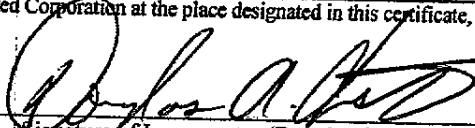
