

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Juveniles Encircled with Excellent Leadership, Inc.

A Non-Profit Corporation



- Article 1: The name of the corporation shall be Juveniles Encircled With Excellent Leadership, Inc.
- Article 2: The Place in this State where the principal office of the Corporation is to be initially located is 4524 Oak Fair Blvd., Tampa, Florida 33610.
- Article 3: Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code. The specific purpose of the corporation is to improve services provided to the youth of the communities within the State of Florida by enhancing detention officer training.
- Article 4: The Corporation shall have three directors appointed by the Registered Agent. The initial director's names are:

Article 5: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 3 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except in an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation.

Article 6: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one of more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are operated exclusively for such purposes.
