### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

DELRAY YOUTH ENRICHMENT DEVELOPMENT CENTER, INC

For the purpose of organizing a non-profit, non-stock corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned states as follows:

### **ARTICLE I**

The name of the Corporation shall be **DELRAY YOUTH ENRICHMENT DEVELOPMENT CENTER, INC.** (hereinafter, the "Corporation").

### ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation shall be in care of Borton Motors, Inc., 2201 N. Federal Highway, in the City of Delray Beach, County of Palm Beach, Florida 33483.

### ARTICLE III

The Corporation is not organized for profit and shall not have authority to issue capital stock.

# ARTICLE IV

The purpose for which this Corporation is organized is to provide, foster, enhance and disseminate learning and education in the development of human mechanical skills by disadvantaged and unskilled youth, relating generally to automotive and vehicular products together with additional vocational pursuits, all in the public interest. This Corporation shall engage in such exclusively charitable and educational activities as shall qualify it for exemption from taxation under Section

501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, (the "Code"), or any successor section or statute of similar import, as an organization described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code. In furtherance of the foregoing charitable and educational purposes, the Corporation shall develop, disseminate and apply knowledge with respect to development of human mechanical skills and further vocational pursuits by the disadvantaged and unskilled, as aforesaid, in the public interest and, in particular, the Corporation shall:

- 1. conduct research, writing and seminars relating to the development and enhancement of human mechanical skills and further vocational pursuits by disadvantaged and unskilled youth,
- 2. promote and contribute to the training of teachers and other educators in ways to enrich and enhance such human mechanical skills and further vocational pursuits in youthful students,
- 3. identify, foster and publish literature that is designed to stimulate such skills in disadvantaged and unskilled youth, generally,
- 4. to promote a broader awareness by the public of the importance of instructing youth in education and training involving human mechanical skills and other vocational pursuits.

In furtherance of the foregoing charitable and educational purposes, the Corporation shall:

Collect, accept, hold, invest, reinvest, and administer any gifts, grants, bequests, devises, benefits of trusts, and property of any sort, without limitation as to value or amount, and apply the income and principal thereof and make grants and contributions, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine, as follows:

- (a) to or for the use of one or more charitable entity or charitable entities for charitable or educational purposes;
- (b) to or for the use of one or more of the United States of America, any state territory, or possession of the United States, and any political subdivision thereof, exclusively for public purposes; and
- (c) directly for charitable or educational purposes, without making use of any other charitable entity.

(d) Alone or in cooperation with other persons, organizations, or institutions, conduct any and all other activities and do any and all acts and things which may be necessary, useful, suitable, or proper in connection with or for the furtherance, accomplishment, or attainment of such charitable and educational purposes as are lawful for a corporation organized under the Florida General Corporation Law and for a corporation which qualifies for exemption from taxation as an organization described in Code Section 501 (c) (3).

### ARTICLE V

At each annual meeting of the Board of Directors, in excess of one-half of the entire Board of Directors present at such meeting, shall elect a new Board of Directors for a term of one year.
