#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AMVETS POST #4, INC



#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we the undersigned, residents of the State of Florida and citizens of the United States of America, of full age of majority, have for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, in Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., Not For Profit, for the purposes expressed in ARTICLE III hereof, adopted the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The Name of this corporation shall be AMVETS POST #4, INC and its duration is to be perpetual.

## ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 1014 Skipper Rd., Tampa, FL 33613

#### <u> ARTICLE III – PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this non-profit corporation is to operate a Veterans Club. It's mission is to uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States, to safeguard the principals of freedom, liberty, and justice for all. To promote the cause of peace and goodwill among nations, to maintain the freedom of our country, to preserve the fundamentals of democracy, to perpetuate the friendship and associations of the Second World War, and the Korean and Vietnam Wars. To dedicate ourselves to the cause of mutual assistance, by the Grace of God. To engage in any lawful activity permitted by the State of Florida. Notwithstanding any provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not engage in any political activity proscribed by Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, of the United States of America, nor shall any income or assets of the corporation inure to the benefit of any member, private individual or business entity.

## ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION

The Board of Directors of this Corporation shall be elected at the Post's General meeting in May of each year. Nominations are taken from the floor from members in good standing of the post, and the nominated slate is then elected by

the members in good standing. The nominees receiving a majority of the votes are elected to their respected office. The Board of Directors/Officers will serve a one-year term. Directors will also hold the positions of officers of the corporation.

## **ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION**

Upon dissolution of the corporation for any cause, all of the assets and property, both real and personal, then owned or controlled by this corporation shall revert to and become the property of an non-profit institution accorded tax-exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, of the United States of America, to be designated by the board of Directors/Officers; provided, however, that the just debts and liabilities of the corporation shall first be paid. Upon dissolution, none of the assets or property of the corporation shall devolve to the benefit of any private individual or business entity of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE IX - BYLAWS

The by-laws of the corporation may be made, altered, or rescinded by the Board of Directors / Officers of the corporation, through regular or special meeting.

#### ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS

These Articles may be amended at any regular meeting of the membership of the cooperation, or at a special meeting called for that purpose, by a majority of the members in good standing.

#### ARTICLE XL - INUREMENT

No part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefits of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for service rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c) (3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)
