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<u>ARTICLE I - NAME</u>

The name of the non-profit organization shall be:

A MOTHER'S TOUCH LEARNING AND OUTREACH CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II- PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

6272 Northwest 186th Street, Suite 202 Miami, Florida 33015

ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

This corporation in a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation Law, for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self-sufficiency. The programs will consist of but not be limited to: Early Child Development, Seminars, Outreach Advocacy for the Homeless and Disadvantaged, Health Care, Housing Employment, Literacy, Counseling, Teen Pregnancy, Job Training, Job Placement and Acquisition, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, Tutoring, AIDS Awareness, Elderly Care and other programs to aid those in need.

(a) This organization will endeavor to enrich and cultivate the minds of children, through meaningful learning experiences. The organization shall incorporate all of the modalities of learning that include the following: sensory motor, cognitive, tactical, visual, auditory and expressive language. This organization is further organized and operated to provide tutorial services in academic studies to individuals requiring additional help that may not be available at their respective educational institutions. The organization will further endeavor to provide a safe learning environment to children in low-income families, especially children with disabilities, during after- school hours, summer recess etc. The organization will also endeavor to educate parents and caregivers about the importance of an adequate education, along with all other charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(b) Not- withstanding any other provisions of these articles the corporation shall not carry on any other activity not permitted to carry on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contribution to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV: DURATION

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual. The corporation shall have no stock and shall have no members.

ARTICLE- MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The directors are elected in accordance with the By-Laws of the organization. The Board of Directors shall be comprised of no less (2) and no more than twenty-one (21) elected members. The Executive Director of the corporation shall be an ex-officio member of the board with voting privileges.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization id then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
