**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
YOUTH SOLUTIONS, INC.,**

 The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, State of Florida, Chapter 617, and the pertinent subsections of the Florida Statutes as same may now or hereafter exist, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation shall be YOUTH SOLUTIONS INC.,

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, literary, or educational, within the meaning of section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provisions of any future or existing, United States Internal Revenue law.

General nature and object of this not-for-profit corporation shall be to preach, teach, sing, act out, promote, disseminate and advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ both in the United States and abroad and thus fulfill the command of our Lord Jesus Christ and His gospel to preach in all the world as a

witness for all nations. Additionally YOUTH SOLUTIONS INC. is also a ministry for the purpose of consulting local churches and their youth ministries. We shall empower the local church to reach out to its community. The goal is to see all youth come to know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior through real and relevant outreaches. It is the vision of this organization to also see youth be empowered to live a wholesome life, be employed, learn skills so they may contribute to society and to become better citizens.

This not-for-profit corporation is to facilitate, engender, and promote contributions from any and all public agencies, the State of Florida or any other state, appropriate Federal Agencies, and private individuals and/or organizations that may be available in finding and obtaining appropriate support for its specified programs and purposes. Additionally, this corporation is permitted to undertake, assist, create and provide direction in the acquisition of funds that are available.

In addition to the foregoing, and not intended to be limited thereby, to do any and all things provided for and consistent with section 617 of the Florida Statutes relating to not-for-profit corporations.

ARTICLE IV: CORPORATE POWERS

The corporation shall have and exercise all powers authorized by law to be conferred upon or exercised by such a corporation, including those enumerated in all the applicable laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.

ARTICLE V: DURATION

ARTICLE VII: NO CAPITOL STOCK

The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit nor shall it have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends, and no part of its earnings shall inure to the benefit of any Director, Trustee, Officer, or individual. The balance of all monies received by the corporation from its operations, after payment in full of all salaries, benefits, debts and obligations of the corporation of whatsoever kind and nature, shall be used and distributed exclusively for carrying out the purposes of the corporation set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE VIII: ORGANIZATION EXCLUSIVELY FOR TAX-EXEMPT PURPOSES

Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)

ARTICLE IX: DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution or winding up of the Corporation all of its remaining assets after payments of its liabilities shall be distributed to one or more ministries of similar purpose and vision as may be determined by the Directors of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X: INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify any Director, Officer, or former Director and Officer, against expenses actually and necessarily incurred by him/her or any amount paid in satisfaction of judgments in connection with any suit or proceeding, whether civil or criminal in nature, in which he/she is made a party by reason of being or having been such Director or Officer.


ARTICLE XI: DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall consist of three or more individuals with the number specified in or fixed in accordance with the by-laws of the Corporation. The President of the Corporation shall appoint all Directors.

ARTICLE XII: AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in the Articles of Incorporation, or any amendments hereto, and to enact By-Laws, the in manner now or hereafter prescribed by law and all rights conferred on Directors and Officers herein are granted subject to this reservation.

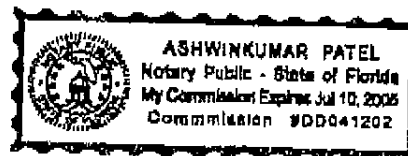

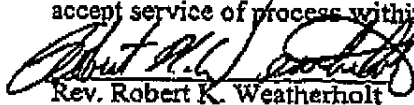
