ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KIWANIS CLUB OF TEMPLE TERRACE, FLORIDA, INCORPORATED (a corporation not for profit)



The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Kiwanis Club of Temple Terrace, Florida, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business shall be 6609 Glencoe Drive, Temple Terrace, Florida 33617. The mailing address shall be P. O. Box 291151, Temple Terrace, Florida 33687-1151.

ARTICLE III

The purposes of the corporation are:

- 1. To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
- 2. To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.
- 3. To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business, and professional standards.
- 4. To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive, and serviceable citizenship.
- 5. To provide through this club, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service, and to build better communities.
- 6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.
- 7. For the purposes aforesaid, to take over the assets, rights and franchises of the unincorporated club, known as the Kiwanis Club of Temple Terrace, Florida, and its members.
- 8. To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

ARTICLE IV

The Board of Directors shall consist of all officers and not less than five (5) directors of the club. Officers and directors shall be elected by members at the annual meeting of the club as set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VIII

That whenever requested by the Board of Trustees of Kiwanis International the corporation will dissolve change its form of organization, and that no change in the corporate structure, or in the purposes and powers of the corporation should be made without the consent of Kiwanis International.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the governing board shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets or the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation, in such manner to such organization or organizations organized or operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), as the governing board shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX

The effective date of these Articles of Incorporation shall be January 15, 2002.
