## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

## FLYING FISH PARENTS ASSOCIATION, INC., A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, and filed accordance with Section 617.01201, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation, filed with the Secretary of State, Tallahassee, Florida, on May 25, 2001, effective May 23, 2001:

FIRST: The following Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation were approved by the Board of Directors and are hereby added to and shall be incorporated in the Articles of incorporation.

"Article III. A. The purposes for which the operation of Flying Fish Parents Association, Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 401(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Article III. B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Article III. C. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, state, or local government for exclusive public purpose."

SECOND: The date of adoption of the Articles of Amendment was: January 7, 2002.

**THIRD:** Adoption of Amendment. There are no members or member entitled to vote on the Amendments. The Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the unanimous written consent of the Board of Directors.
