**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
GLORIOUS CREATIONS MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL, INC.
A FLORIDA NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION**

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The undersigned persons, acting as incorporators of a corporation not for profit under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLES I

The name of the corporation is Glorious Creations Ministries International, Inc.

ARTICLES II

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is 1248 North Jefferson Street, Monticello, Florida 32344, city of Monticello, Jefferson County, State of Florida.

ARTICLES III

The corporation is a not for profit corporation. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are charitable and religious purposes.

- (a) The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of religion and for other charitable purposes, and particularly for religious and charitable purposes.
- (b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed to operate exclusively for such religious purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 510 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, for such purposes, the making of distributing to organizations which qualify as tax exempt organizations under that code.
- (c) The corporation shall now, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis as defined in Section 617.011 of the Florida Statutes. The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of directors. The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different

classes of membership, if any, the property, voting, and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as regulated by the bylaws.

ARTICLES V

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1248 North Jefferson Street, Monticello, Florida 32344, City of Monticello, Jefferson County, State of Florida. The name of its initial registered agent at such address is Dr. Glenda M. Gilley-Thompson.

ARTICLES VI

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its property controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be 3; provided, however, that such number may be changed by a bylaw duly adopted pursuant to the bylaws of this corporation.

The directors named herein as the first board of directors shall hold office until the first meeting of members, to be held on July 1st of every year, at 12:00 p.m. at 1248 North Jefferson Street, Monticello, Florida 32344, City of Monticello, Jefferson County, State of Florida, at which time an election of directors shall be held.

Directors elected at the first annual meeting, and at all times thereafter, shall serve for a term of one year until the second annual meeting of member following the election of directors and until the qualification of the successors in office. Annual meetings shall be held at 12:00 p.m., on the 1st day of July of each year at the principle office of the corporation, or at such other place or places as the board of directors may designate from time to time by resolution.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the board of directors under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all the members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force.

ARTICLES IX

Subject to the limitations contained in the bylaws and any limitations set forth in the Not For Profit Corporation Act of Florida described above, concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members of the corporation, the bylaws if the corporation may be made, altered, either by the resolution of the board of directors or by following the procedures set forth therefor in the bylaws.

ARTICLES X

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious and charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officers, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLES XI

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to a not for profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for religious and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws and effects as of taken by unanimous vote of the directors. Any certificates of other document filed under any provision of the law relation to action was taken by unanimous written consent of the board of directors without a meeting and that the articles of incorporation and bylaws of this corporation authorize the directors to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

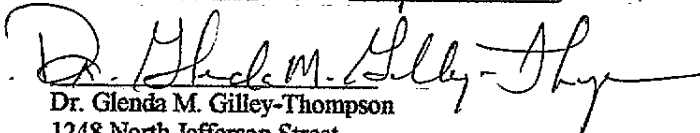
ARTICLES XII


Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the board of directors and presented to a quorum of members for their vote.

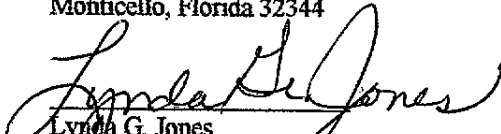
Amendments may be adopted by a vote of at least two-thirds of a quorum of members of the corporation.

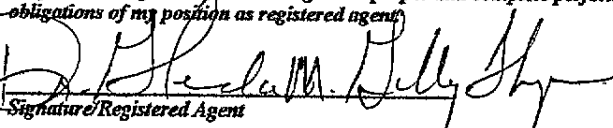
