ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WOODLANDS ELEMENTARY PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION, INC

(A Corporation Not For Profit)

In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes Chapter 617, the undersigned, with other persons, being desirous of forming a corporation authorized to exercise powers permitted non-profit corporations, does agree to the following:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is **WOODLANDS ELEMENTARY PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION, INC** with its principal place of business located at 1420 E.E. Williamson Road, Longwood, Seminole County, Florida 32750.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence, unless dissolved by law or as provided by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To promote the welfare of the children and youth in home, school, community and place of worship;
- (b) To raise the standards of home life;
- (c) To secure adequate laws for the care and protection of children and youth;

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ARTICLE VIII - ELECTION AND APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which directors are elected or appointed shall be defined and regulated in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX - POWERS and DIRECTORS

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its property controlled and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall not be less than three (3) initially, with that number being determined in the future as indicated by the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE X

No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of this corporation and upon dissolution of this organization, all of its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to organizations which are qualified for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose, none of the assets shall be distributed to any member, officer or trustee of this corporation. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue laws, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or any other corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal

(d) To bring into closer relation the home and the school, that parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the education of children and youth;

(e) To develop between educators and the general public such united efforts as will secure for all children and youth the highest advantages in physical, mental, social and spiritual education;

(f) All purposes are to be advanced without regard to race, age, sex, color, creed, religion, or national origin.

ARTICLE IV - STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

This is a non-profit corporation organized solely for and having all of the rights, authority, powers and possessing the general purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit Law set forth in Part 1 of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE V - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The county in the State of Florida where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located in the County of Seminole, at 1420 E.E. Williamson Road, Longwood, Florida 32750, and the name of the initial Registered Agent of this corporation is Frank C. Whigham .

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP

The qualification for membership and the manner of their admission into the corporation shall be defined and regulated in

Revenue Law, and in addition, notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation is formed exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

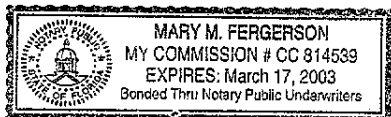

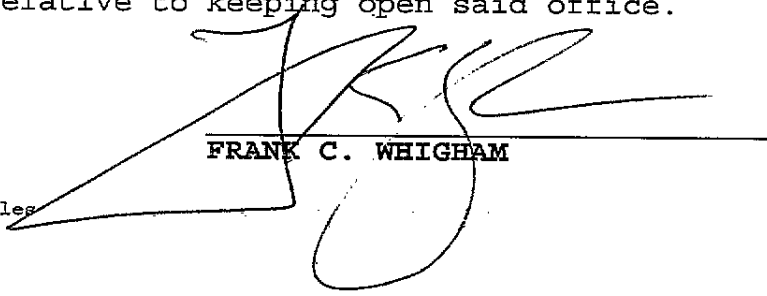
