Article VIII

This corporation shall be authorized to carry out any and all acts and to exercise any and all corporate powers which may now or hereafter be lawful under the laws of the State of Florida to the extent applicable to corporations not for profit and that are not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these Articles of Incorporation to the contrary, the following provisions apply:

1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to it's members, directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article
2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign.
3. No withstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on other activities not permitted to be carried out by a corporation exempt from federal income tax.
