### ARTICLE I Name, Street Address and Mailing Address

### ARTICLE II Term of Existence

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### ARTICLE III Purpose

The Corporation's purpose shall be to be organized and to operate exclusively for the promotion of social welfare, including, but not limited to the following:

- (1) Increase public awareness of the current state of marriage infidelity laws, guardianship laws and end-of-life issues.
- (2) Provide financial aid and public awareness efforts in situations where a court may order the removal of life-sustaining care for an incapacitated person.
- (3) Advocate the position of people living with disabilities.
- (4) Encourage the government to take action against dangerous guardianship laws and end of life laws.
- (5) Address health policy concerns of people with disabilities and their families, including cuthanasia and assisted suicide.

The Corporation shall have all powers now or hereafter granted by law, and in addition thereto shall have all powers lawfully necessary or required to carry out its purposes and objects. All of the assets or earnings shall be used exclusively for the purposes hereinabove set out, including payment of expenses incidental thereto.

### ARTICLE IV Members

The qualifications of members and the manner of admission of members shall be as specified in the bylaws of the Corporation.

### ARTICLE V Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the registered office of the corporation is 4221 W. Boy Scout Boulevard, Suite 1000, Tampa, Florida 33607, and the name of its registered agent at such address is CFRA, LLC.

#### ARTICLE VI <u>Directors</u>

The corporation shall have three (3) directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time and their election and appointment shall be as specified in the bylaws of the corporation, provided that the corporation shall always have at least three directors.
