Articles of Incorporation For 2002 FEB 11 M 10: 21 Ssafe Landings Foundation, Incorporated FLORIDA FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617. Florida statues, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I - Name

The name of the Corporation is **Ssafe Landings Foundation, Incorporated.**

Article II - Principle Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principle place of business and mailing address for the Corporation shall be 6410 Brae-Burn, North Lauderdale, Florida 33068. The Corporation may establish other principle places of business and other offices, either within or without the State of Florida, as the Corporation may from time to time determine.

Article III - Purpose

The Corporation is organized exclusively charitable, religious, educational, literary, and scientific purposes formed to improve the quality of life for individuals through activities that primarily include but are not limited to the following:

- Development of low-income decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable housing beneficial to the public interest,
- Provisions of basic living support services and case management activities, and
- Education instruction and networking activities that provide basic living information to the needy and channels resources that are useful to economically disadvantaged individuals, recovering addicts and beneficial to the community.

To this end the corporation shall at times be operated for purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including for such purpose, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended. All funds whether income or principle, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to the aforementioned purposes.

Article IV - Manner of Election of Directors

The manner of election of the Board of Directors shall be by appointment by the initial incorporator(s).

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- 1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to it members, trustees, officers, or other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make payments and distribution in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III herein.
- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these article, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carries on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as hereafter amended.

Article VIII- Membership
