Articles of Incorporation

Community Access to Resources and Education Points, Inc.

We the undersigned, each of whom are citizens of the Untied States, desiring to form a not-for-profit corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act to the State of Florida, pursuant to Chapter 617, of the Florida Statues, do hereby adopt and certify the following Articles of Incorporation for such a Corporation.

Article I

Name: The name of this organization shall be Community Access to Resources and Education Points, Inc. It shall be incorporated as a Not-For-Profit Corporation under the Not For Profit Corporation Act of the State of Florida.

Principal Office: The principal office of the Corporation in the State of Florida shall Be located in the City of Kissimmee, County of Osceola. The Corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of Florida, as the Board of Directors may designate or as the business of the Corporation may require from time to time.

The current mailing address for the principal office is:

297 Torpoint Gate Road, Longwood, Florida 32779

Registered Office: The registered office of the Corporation maintained in the State of Florida, may be, but not be, identical with the principal business office in the State of Florida, and the Board of Directors may change the address of the registered office from time to time.

Article II

The period of duration of this Corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to Article IX of these Articles of Incorporation or the Florida Not For Profit Act. Corporation existence will commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Secretary of State of Florida.

Article III

The purpose of Community Access to Resources and Education Points, Inc., a private, not-for-profit corporation in Kissimmee, Osceola County, Florida, is to ensure the availability of quality, comprehensive primary healthcare and prevention education services to include HIV/AIDS services to individuals with general goals, objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be as follows:

a. To establish, maintain and specialize in the delivery of primary health cares services and preventative health education, including HIV/AIDS services. The principle mission of the organization shall be to honor the right of every person, regardless of race, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or economic status to obtain primary healthcare services and prevention education related to illness to include HIV/AIDS diagnosis.

- b. To receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, and to apply the whole or any part of the income thereof exclusively for charitable healthcare and educational purposes either directly or by contribution to the organization that qualifies as an exempt organization under the 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- c. To develop systems to insure efficient operation, continuation and expansion of high quality services and programs.
- d. To research and evaluate services, programs and funding to continuously improve services to individuals and families.
- e. To inform and educate the residents of the counties of Osceola, Orange, Lake, Seminole, Brevard, Polk and Hillsboro Counties as well as the policy makers of the need for services for underserved populations.
- f. To develop resources and training for programs and staff, work with existing community agencies and organization whenever possible to enhance services related to healthcare, and prevention education and social services.
- g. To identify gaps in the current systems of care for persons in need of primary care services and prevention education services.
- h. To provide management and support services to the organization.

This Corporation shall be authorized to exercise the powers permitted not for profit corporations under chapter 617, the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, of the Florida Statues: provided that this Corporation is exercising any one or more powers will do so in furtherance of the exempt status for which it has been organized as described in section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article IV

The qualifications for Board members and the admission requirements and terms are established in the Bylaws of the said Corporation.

Article V

Article VI

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is four (4). The board shall be composed of no less than four (4) members, the exact number to be determined annually by the board of Directors. Article VII

The Board of Directors is empowered to create, alter or repeal the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation without restrictions of their powers conferred by statute.

Article VIII

No part of the net earning of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation or services rendered, to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the activities set forth in Article III hereof. The Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on ay a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article IX

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Sections 501 $\mathbb O$ (3) and 170 $\mathbb O$ (2) of the Internal Revenue code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.
