ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SJS 1977 REUNION, INC.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator for the purpose of forming a not for profit Corporation under the provisions of Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby delivers the following Articles of Incorporation for said Corporation to the Department of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation is:

SJS 1977 REUNION, INC.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The Corporation may engage or transact in any or all lawful activities or businesses permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida, or any other state, country, territory or nation. However, no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE III POWERS OF CORPORATION

3.1 The Corporation shall possess and exercise all the powers and privileges granted by Chapters 607 and 617 of the Florida Statutes as they now exist or as they may be hereafter

3.2 The Corporation is organized not for profit and no part of the income of said Corporation shall ever be distributed to or enure to the benefit of any member, trustee or officer; provided, however, that compensation in reasonable amounts may be paid for services rendered, that benefits may be conferred and that distributions may be made in accordance with Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IV NON-STOCK MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION

The Corporation shall be organized as a non-stock membership corporation. Qualifications for members and the manner of their admission to membership in the Corporation shall be as regulated by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V BOARD OF TRUSTEES

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of, a Board of Trustees, except as may be otherwise provided in these Articles of Incorporation or in the bylaws of the Corporation, or as may be otherwise required by any of the provisions of Chapters 607 and 617 of the Florida Statues as it now exists or as it may be hereafter amended. The number of Trustees shall be determined and fixed pursuant to the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall consist of at least three (3) persons. The manner in which the trustees shall be elected or appointed shall be set forth in the Bylaws.
