ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ED COST ORUNMILA YOUNGSTERS INTERNATIONAL INCORPORATED - FLORIDA BRANCH

A FLORIDA NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

Article 1. Name. The name of this Corporation is: Orunmila Youngsters International Incorporated (hereinafter referred to as "OYIN") - Florida Branch.

Article 2. Corporate Address. The street address of the Corporation's initial principal office is: 4393C Woodstock Drive, West Palm Beach, Florida 33409 [and, if different, the Corporation's mailing address is: P. O. Box 16882, West Palm Beach, Florida 33416.]

Article 3. Purposes. The purpose of the Corporation is as follows:

A. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation is the promotion of Ifa and the tenets thereof; and is exclusively for charitable, cultural, religious, patriotic, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to corporations that qualify as exempt corporations under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

- B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.
- D. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section (501)(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal

government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such corporation(s), as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operate exclusively for such purposes.

Article 4. Number, Qualification, Election and Tenure of Directors. Directors shall be elected by the members at each second annual meeting of Members, and shall serve two years or until the next succeeding annual meeting, and until their successors have been elected and qualified. Directors shall not hold any position for more than two consecutive terms.
