ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF APCO FOUNDATION, INC.



Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Elorida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

1. Article 1 of the Articles of Incorporation of APCO Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation") is amended as follows:

"The name of the corporation is: "The Public Safety Foundation of America, Inc."

2. Article 3 A. shall be amended to read as follows:

A. To operate exclusively for charitable and educational purposes as defined in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding section of any future tax code (IRC). These operations are limited to fostering and promoting the interests of APCO International, Inc., a publicly-supported organization. These interests include, but are not limited to, assisting and educating public safety agencies regarding the implementation of call locating technologies. In furtherance of such purposes, this corporation may make distributions to Federal, state, or local governments or agencies, or organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under IRC 501(c)(3).

The remainder of Article³ shall-emain unchanged.

3. The foregoing amendment was adopted by the board of directors of the corporation on February _37, 2003. There are no members of the corporation.
