ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NEFSKY GROUP INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Afficies Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name, address and principal place of business of the corporation is:

In addition to the office of the corporation registered with the Secretary of State of Florida, the corporation may also have offices at such places both within and without the State of Florida as the Board of Governors may from time to time determine or the business of the corporation may require.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized and the general nature of the object of the organization shall be to cultivate, promote, and develop the economic welfare and enhancement of neighborhoods, schools and community groups by instituting on a community level skill training in various trades and industries, including but not limited to the aviation industry, automotive industry and health fields; to create institutions of higher learning based thereon with the goal of preventing high school drop out and fostering the opportunity and desire to enter college, and to do lawfully all and everything necessary and suitable and proper in furtherance thereof, and to otherwise engage in any other activity necessary for the achievement of its objectives suject to the restrictions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes relating to corporations not for profit, and other than those activities which might disqualify the corporation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

ARTICLE III REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE IV INCORPORATORS

ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time as provided in the By-Laws but shall never be less than 3 or more than five.

ARTICLE VI OFFICERS

The corporation shall have a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer and such other officers as the Board of Directors from time to time by resolution create and who shall be elected according to the By-Laws of the corporation. Commencing on the date of filing of the Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State the duration of the corporation is perpetual unless sooner liquidated or dissolved in accordance with law.

ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENT

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment hereto, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX BY-LAWS

The By-laws of the corporation shall be made and adopted by a majority of the Board of Directors at the first meeting. The By-Laws of this corporation shall be for the government of the corporation and may contain any provisions or requirements for the management or conduct of the affairs and business of the corporation, provided that they are not inconsistent with the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation or contrary to the laws of this State or of the United States.
