# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

(A Florida Not For Profit Corporation)

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

#### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

# FIRST TIME NEW BEGINNINGS, INC.

# ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation shall be:

3 Valley Drive Daytona Beach, FL 32117

### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

- A. The general purposes and objects of the Corporation are to engage in charitable activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, in such a manner as to qualify the Corporation for exemption from income tax under said Section.
- B. The specific purposes of the Corporation shall include, but not be limited to, providing a shelter home for pregnant teenagers under the age of 18 years, and to act as a referral service to provide its residents and other pregnant females with information regarding governmental and other resources and services available to them; and such other purposes and activities as would be appropriate to accomplish the basic objects of the Corporation.

C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

# ARTICLE IV - INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND ADDRESS

# ARTICLE VII - DISSOLUTION

The balance of all money and other property received by the Corporation from any source after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation shall be used or distributed to other organizations which support the performing arts and which themselves are exempt organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government for public purpose.
