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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undesigned incorporator(s) for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is: Douglas Assisted Living Facility, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of Florida Business Corporation Code, and the duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

ARTICLE SIX

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of no members at this time. However, the manner of election will be stated in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The corporation is a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purpose of this corporation is to:

- To provide quality care for the participants
- To provide shelter, food, transportation for the elderly, mentally retarded.
- To provide this service to anyone that needs it.

To render all services ands advice related above.

Provided, however the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by a non-profit corporation under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall unire to the benefits of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay any reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.

ARTICLE EIGHT

The corporation is organized (and shall be operated) on a non-stock basis within meaning of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, and shall not have the power to issue shares of any type of any class of stock, but may issue membership certificates, section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE NINE

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt

organizations under section 501 (C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE TEN

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set fourth in the purpose clause hereto:

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Not withstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE ELEVEN

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be disposed of by Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
