ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FSMTA ASSOCIATION SERVICES, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of F.S. Chapter 617, the undersigned, being a natural person, hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a not for profit business corporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation ("Corporation") is the FSMTA Association Services, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DATE OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the Corporation shall begin on *May 15, 2002*

ARTICLE III - ADDRESS

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 1089 W. Morse Blvd., Ste. C, Winter Park, FL 32789.

ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED AGENT

The initial street address of the Corporation's registered office is Magnolia Centre, Suite 102, 1203 Governor's Square Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32301-2960. The initial registered agent for the Corporation at that address is Paul Watson Lambert.

ARTICLE VI - PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation is to engage in lawful business by providing services to the members of the Florida State Massage Therapy Association, Inc., and that of other association, the profits from which are to be used to benefit the membership of the Florida State Massage Therapy Association, Inc., by using those profits to promote the massage therapy profession, to provide membership services, to promote research and education and for such other purposes as may benefit that membership.

ARTICLE VII - COMPENSATION

The officers and directors of the corporation shall serve without compensation as volunteers. The corporation may pay just and reasonable compensation to employed staff, consultants, accounts and lawyers. However, a member of the Board of Directors is entitled to reasonable, just and earned compensation or commission for providing professional services to the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

Any assets of the corporation of the corporation remaining upon dissolution after satisfying all existing obligations and debts shall be distributed to the Florida State Massage Therapy Association, Inc., as a contribution.

ARTICLE IX - BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

The members of the Executive Committee of the Florida State Massage Therapy Association, Inc., shall serve as the Officers of the corporation: The President, the State First Vice President, the State Second Vice President, the State Secretary and the State Treasurer of the Florida State Massage Therapy Association, Inc., shall each serve respectively as the President, the First Vice President, the Second Vice President, the Secretary and the Treasurer of the corporation. The Executive Board of the Florida State Massage Therapy Association, Inc., shall be the Board of Directors.
