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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
WORD ALIVE MINISTRIES
LEARNING ENRICHMENT CENTER, INC.

The undersigned , acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation shall be; Word Alive Ministries Learning Enrichment Center, Inc.

ARTICLE II
DURATION

The term shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III
PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be; 1020 North Kentucky Avenue, Lakeland, Florida 33805.

ARTICLE IV
PURPOSES

This is a not for profit corporation. The corporations' primary activity is to provide care for children away from their homes, thus enabling parents to be gainfully

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employed or to seek employment. These services are available to the general public.

As an integral part of Word Alive Ministries, Inc., we are committed to the enrichment of the entire family. The Learning Enrichment Center will administer and perform such other functions as deemed necessary or desirable to carry out the mission of the Center directly or indirectly.

ARTICLE V BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall be composed of not less than three (3) and no more than five (5) persons to manage the affairs of the Center. The manner in which the directors are appointed shall be stated in the bylaws of this Center.

ARTICLE VI DISSOLUTION

The regulation of internal affairs of the Center, including the distribution of assets on dissolution, shall be provided for in the bylaws and shall include that:

- (1) No part of the net earnings of the Center shall inure to the benefit or be distributed to its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth above.
- (2) Upon dissolution of the Center or winding down of its affairs, the assets of the Center shall be applied and distributed as follows:
 - (a) All liabilities and obligations of the Center shall be paid, satisfied and discharged, or adequate provisions shall be made.
 - (b) Assets held by the Center upon condition requiring, return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution or winding down, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements; and

- (c) All remaining assets not disposed of under either of the preceding paragraphs(a) or (b) shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more religious, charitable, or educational organizations, (1) which are described in Section 501(c)3 to which deductible contributions can be made as the Board of Directors shall select.

ARTICLE VII INDEMNIFICATION

Every director and officer of the corporation shall be indemnified by the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed in connection with any proceeding or any settlement of any proceeding (including any appeal) to which a director may be party or may become involved by reason of being or having been a director or officer as such expense is incurred, except when the director or officer is adjudged guilty of, or liable for, willful misfeasance in the performance of duties; provided that in the event of a settlement before entry of judgement, the indemnification shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being in the best interest of the corporation. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such director or officer may be entitled by law. Appropriate liability insurance shall be provided for every officer, director and agent of the corporation in amounts determined from time to time by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VIII FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the corporation shall begin January 1st and end December 31st of each calendar year.

ARTICLE IX TERRITORY

The territory in which the operation of the Center is principally to be conducted is Polk County, and Central Florida.

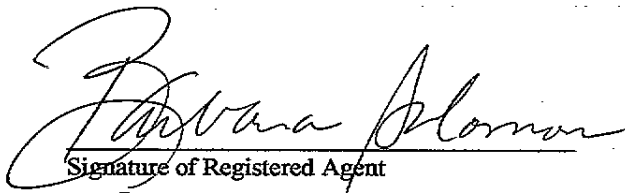
