Articles of Incorporation of MILLENNIUM CHRISTIAN MINISTRY FOUNDATION, INC. A Florida Nonprofit Corporation

Article 1. Name. The name of the corporation is: MILLENNIUM CHRISTIAN MINISTRY FOUNDATION, INC.

Article 2. Duration. The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. Purpose. The purpose of the corporation is as follows:

Article 3. Purpose.

A. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, of the Florida Statutes. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal revenue laws.

B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal revenue laws.

C. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas, of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

D. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.

Article 4. Members. The corporation shall have Voting Members, who shall be Page 1 of Five Pages

elected (and may be removed) by the Voting Members, and who shall have all the rights privileges of members of the corporation. The By-laws may provide for Non-voting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such number and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the By-laws, but who shall not have the right to vote. The By-laws shall provide for the method of election of all Directors, and the number of Directors may be raised or lowered by amendment of the By-laws, but shall in no case be less than three.

Each officer shall be elected by the Board of Directors (and may be removed by the Board of Directors) at such time and in such manner as may be prescribed by the By-laws.
