RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CORPORATIONS OF FLORIDA'S CHILDREN FIRST!, INC.

The Articles of Incorporation of Florida Children's First!, Inc., a Florida corporation not for profit organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and formed under document number N02000004746, filed on June 21, 2002, having been amended, are restated to read as follows:

Article 1 Name

The name of this corporation is:

Article 2 Corporate Purposes

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The corporation shall not operate for pecuniary profit, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure in whole or in part to the benefit of any person having a personal and private interest in the activities of the corporation.
