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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE ANDREW R. FERRELL FOUNDATION, INC. (A Florida Nonprofit Corporation)

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ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation shall be THE ANDREW R. FERRELL FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II: COMMENCEMENT & DURATION AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be a the time of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Florida Secretary of State. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual, unless it is hereafter dissolved according to law.

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 125 Seagull Lane, Sarasota, Florida 34236.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

This corporation is being formed for the purpose of raising funds in support of programs and organizations which benefit children who are experiencing life threatening illnesses, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. That is, it shall be exclusively to conduct fund raising programs and events, and to use the funds generated by such efforts to support and establish programs and organizations whose services enhance the lives of children affected by life threatening illnesses. All activities of the corporation shall be conducted within the laws of Florida and of the United States.

This corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for non-profit purposes; and no part of the income or assets of the corporation shall be distributed to, nor inure to the benefit of any individual.

ARTICLE IV: POWERS

This corporation may do and perform all such acts and things, including those generally allowed by the laws of Florida relative to nonprofit corporations, as now existing, or as the law may henceforth provide, as from time to time may be necessary or expedient to the exercise of any and all of its corporate functions, powers, and rights.

However, this corporation, in exercising any one or more of such powers shall do so only in furtherance of the exempt purpose for which it was organized as described in the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE V: MEMBERSHIP

Any person who agrees to be bound by these Articles of Incorporation, the corporate Bylaws, and any rules and regulations which the Board of Directors may from time to time adopt, who completes a membership application form and submits it to the Board of Directors, and who pays the applicable dues, if any, is eligible and qualified for membership in this corporation.

The corporate Bylaws may provide the Board of Directors further discretionary powers relating to the admission of members.

ARTICLE VI: MANAGEMENT

This corporation's initial Board of Directors shall have three (3) directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased, from time to time, by an amendment to the corporate Bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3).

The directors of this corporation must, at all times, be members of this corporation. Only a member of this corporation may serve as a director of this corporation. The directors shall be elected annually by this corporation's members. The manner of the election of the directors shall be specified in the Bylaws.

The directors named herein, comprising the initial Board of Directors, shall hold office until their successors are duly qualified.

ARTICLE VIII: OFFICERS

The officers shall consist of a president, a vice president and a secretary/treasurer. This corporation may have such other officers as may be provided in the corporate Bylaws.

The officers shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors. The manner of the election of the officers shall be specified in the corporate Bylaws. The officers named herein, comprising the initial officers, shall hold office until the election of officers at the first annual Board of Directors' meeting, or until their successors are elected and qualified.
