ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TREASURE COAST CHAPTER FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROFESSIONALS, INC. (A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

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Article I: Name

The name of the corporation shall be "Treasure Coast Chapter Florida Association of Environmental Professionals, Inc." hereinafter referred to as "Chapter."

Article II: Principal Office

The principal place of business shall be located at a place to be established by the membership of the Chapter and may be changed from time to time by a majority vote of the membership present at any regular or non-regular membership meeting.

Article III: Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is as a unit of the Florida Association of Environmental Professionals (FAEP) and the National Association of Environmental Professionals (NAEP). As such, the Chapter adopts the goal of these organizations which is: to enhance, maintain and protect the quality of life in the natural and human environment through encouraging compliance with the NAEP code of ethics and cooperation with the goals of NAEP and FAEP; improve public awareness of the need of environmental involvement and enhancement of the image of the environmental professional; improve communication between environmental professionals and the regulated community, and between practitioners within the environmental community; improve methods for the collection and utilization of environmental information and provide a forum for dissemination of this information; encourage, provide resources and carry on research for the benefit of residents and visitors to the Treasure Coast and for concerned professionals in all fields working to the benefit of the environment; and encourage and provide resources for educational programs which will benefit the environment.

Article IV: Manner of Election

Elections for the Chapter Board of Directors are held yearly after June 30th of the year for the following calendar year. An officer or director may succeed himself/herself in office. Elections shall be held by taking nominations from the floor at a general meeting or by nomination forms submitted to the general membership or Chapter Board of Directors beginning two months prior to the election meeting. At the election meeting, officers shall be elected by a simple majority of the members in attendance at that meeting.




