ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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The undersign, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.
