ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

The purpose for which this organization is formed is exclusively for charitable, education, religious. Literary and scientific purposes as described in the nonprofit public benefit law within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the internal Revenue Code.

To establish and maintain a multicultural arts education skills training daycare center for pre k-12 inner city youth. With an emphasis on job creation, computer literacy skills training, parental development workshops, wealth creation for low to moderate income individuals welfare to workforce parents, at risk youth, the general public, the needy, the residents of Miami-Dade and surrounding counties.

To develop comprehensive child development programs for low-income families who meet 100% of the federal poverty guidelines. Ten percent (10%) of the slots are reserved for children with disabilities and /or special needs.

To foster, promote, establish child, youth, adult development programs that reflect local and national initiatives raising community awareness and literacy levels.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, excepts that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. If reference to federal law in articles of incorporation imposes a limitation that is invalid in your state, you may wish to substitute the following for the last sentence of the preceding paragraph: "Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of this corporation.

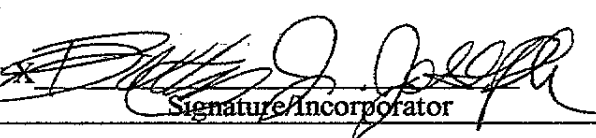
