ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CHARACTER COUNCIL OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, INC.

We, the undersigned incorporators, hereby form and establish a corporation NOT FOR PROFIT under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE FIRST

The name of this corporation is Character Council of Palm Beach County, Inc.

ARTICLE SECOND

The location of its registered office in this state is 4264 Hyacinth Circle South, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida 33410. The registering agent at this address is George A. Bonner. This shall also serve as the corporations principal and mailing address.

ARTICLE THIRD

This Corporation is organized NOT FOR PROFIT and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on are:

- To strengthen the citizens, their families, and the community as a whole by promoting excellence in character, and thereby to help our community become known as a Community of Character.
- 2. To endeavor to gain the support of our community leaders in modeling and promoting good character.

- 3. To learn how character is built into the lives of individuals and adopt character initiatives that apply to each sector within our community.
- 4. To establish a community culture that encourages, recognizes, and rewards good character.
- 5. To emphasize character rather than achievement, since achievement with excellence, by its very nature, requires good character.
- 6. To evaluate the decisions, policies, statutes of our community on the basis of whether they reward good character or promote bad character.
- 7. To assess all our activities on a regular basis to ensure we are making progress toward our goal of becoming a community known for the good character of its citizens.

To further such objects and purposes, the Corporation shall have and may exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon corporations formed under the laws pursuant to and under which this Corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended. Specifically, this Corporation shall have power to acquire, purchase, hold, lease, convey, mortgage and pledge such real and personal property in Florida, other states of the United States, and elsewhere, as shall be necessary or convenient to the transaction of its business and the realization of its objects and purposes.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in all events and under all circumstances, and notwithstanding merger, consolidation, reorganization, termination, dissolution, or winding up of this Corporation, voluntary or involuntary or by operation of law, the following provisions shall apply:

(a) This Corporation shall not have or exercise any power or authority either expressly, by interpretation, or by operation of law, nor shall it directly or indirectly engage in

any activity that would prevent this Corporation from qualifying and continuing to qualify as an organization described in 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

- (b) This Corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit.
- (c) No compensation or payment shall ever be paid or made to any member, officer, director, trustee, creator, or organizer of this Corporation, or substantial contributor to it, except as an allowance for actual expenditures or services actually made or rendered to or for this corporation; and neither the whole nor any portion of the assets or net earnings, current or accumulated, of this Corporation shall ever be distributed to or divided among any such persons; provided, further that neither the whole nor any part or portion of such assets or net earnings shall ever be used for, accrue to, or inure to the benefit of any member or private individual within the meaning of 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- 3. Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, the governing body shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at any time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, as the governing

board shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE FOURTH

The Corporation will NOT have authority to issue capital stock, and the conditions of the membership shall be fixed by the bylaws.

ARTICLE FIFTH

The Board of Directors shall have all powers granted by Florida law and statutes.

ARTICLE SIXTH

No director shall be personally liable to the Corporation or its members for monetary damages for any breach of fiduciary duty by such director as a director. Notwithstanding the foregoing sentence, a director shall be liable to the extent provided by applicable law (i) for breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its members, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (iii) under the provisions of Florida law and any amendments thereto, or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit. No amendment to or repeal of this Article shall apply to or have any effect on the liability or alleged liability of any director of the Corporation for or with respect to any acts or omissions of such director occurring prior to the date when such provision becomes effective.

ARTICLE SEVENTH

The term for which this Corporation is to exist is perpetual.

ARTICLE EIGHTH

No member of this Corporation shall benefit financially from the dissolution thereof. In the event of dissolution of this Corporation, the assets of this Corporation shall be distributed as set forth in ARTICLE THIRD hereof.


