## Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation of Bradenton Community Children's Chorus, Inc. NO2000005781



Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corportation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

\*First: Amendment(s) adopted:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the organization is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes specified in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under IRC 501 (c) (3) or corresponding provisions of any subsequest tax laws.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the organization or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered toor for the organization), and no member, trustee officer of the organization or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the organization's assets on dissolution of the organization.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwist provided by IRC 501 (h) or participating in or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office.

In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the organization shall after payment of necessary expenses thereof be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under section 501 (c) (3) subsequest Federal tax laws or to the Federal government or State of local government for a public purpose, subject to the approval of a Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida.

Second: The date of adoption of the amendment(s) was October 12, 2002.

Third: Adoption of Amendment—The amendment was adopted by the board of directors.
