**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL CAMINO DE SANTIDAD, INC.,
A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be desirable and in the best interests of this Corporation and its shareholders that it be incorporated pursuant to the Florida Non Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617; now, therefore, be it:

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of the original Articles of Incorporation for such corporation be attached hereto and that the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation be hereby adopted as follows:

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a Florida corporation under the Florida Non Profit Corporation Act, Chapter & 17, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is MINISTERIO INTERNACIONAL CAMINO DE SANTIDAD, INC., a Florida Non-Profit Corporation.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual existence. The corporate existence will commence on the filing of these articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This Church is organized for the purpose of Glorifying God in the Salvation of Souls, the Edification of Christians through the teaching of God's Word, the Worldwide Proclamation of the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, the promotion of Godly Worship, the defense of the Faith once delivered, and cooperation with Christian Activities functioning in harmony with God's holy word, Campaigns and any other Christian activities as to provide food, toys, clothes to the poor people of the South Florida until the Lord Jesus Christ returns.

ARTICLE IV. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There shall be five members of the initial board of directors of the Corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors until the first election thereof are as follows:

ARTICLE VI. INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE VII. CONDUCT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The conduct of the affairs of the Corporation will be limited as outlined in the By-laws of the corporation. The powers of the Corporation are to be regulated as outlined in the By-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII. DISSOLUTION OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors, shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes, and shall at that time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). The Board of Directors shall determine that assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine are organized and operated exclusively for the purposes aforementioned.

ARTICLE IX. QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications for membership to the Board of Directors are stated in the By-laws. Directors shall be elected or appointed in accordance with the By-laws.
