# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

### FOR

# LAKEVIEW ELEMENTARY PTO INC.

**DOCUMENT NUMBER: NO2000006697** 

Article III of the Articles of Incorporation are being corrected to better define the corporations purpose and meet the requirements of the Internal Revenue Service for being a tax-exempt corporation.

Article III is being corrected as follows:

## ARTICLE III

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is:

Lakeview Elementary PTO Inc is established as a non-profit organization of teachers and parents whose goal is to enhance the learning environment for the students of Lakeview, an elementary school in the Osceola County, Florida school district.

Lakeview Elementary PTO Inc is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization,

contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by Court of common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.
