ARTICLE I.

The name of the Corporation is: FONDATION DR. JEAN BARTOLI, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IIL

The purpose of the Corporation is as follows:

- A. This Corporation is a not for profit Corporation organized under Chapter 617,

 Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The

 specific purposes of this Corporation are, Charitable and Education: to provide

 education, health program, art program, and sports and recreation to all races and

 socio-economic background, including, for such purposes, the making of

 distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section

 501 c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future

 federal tax code.
- B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code, and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but, the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation.



to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 c (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation shall not be permitted to carry on any activities, except D. insubstantial activities, that are not in furtherance of the exempt purposes. The Corporation shall be prohibited to engage in acts of self-dealing as described by Internal Revenue Code Section 4941 or any similar provision of any future tax code. The minimum charitable distributions as required by Internal Revenue Code Section 4942 or any similar provision of any future tax code must be made. Excess business interests may not be held in contravention of Internal Revenue Code Section 4943 or any similar provision of any future tax code. Jeopardy investments, as prohibited by Internal Revenue Code Section 4944 or any similar provision of any future tax code must not be made. Lobbying expenditures, as prohibited by Internal Revenue Code Section 4945 or any similar provision of any future tax code must not be made.

ARTICLE IV.

The Corporation shall have Voting Members, who shall be elected and or appointed, (and may be removed) by the Voting Members and who shall have the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The bylaws may provided for Non-voting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote.
