ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 6517, F.S., (Not for Profit) 02 SEP 16 AM 8:58

ARTICLE I

Name

SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The name of the corporation shall be The Mercy House of Central Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal Office

The principal office of this corporation has not yet been determined. The mailing address shall be PO Box 550958, Orlando, FL 32805.

ARTICLE III

Purpose(s)

- A. This corporation shall be organized and operated exclusively for temporary/transitional housing and support service purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV

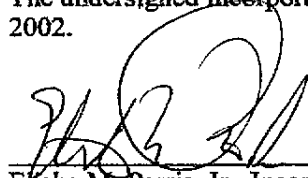
