ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

Pursuant to Chapter § 617, Florida Statutes (F.S.)

ARTICLE I NAME

The Name of the corporation shall be: Heaven Sent Women's Outreach Ministries, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office shall be: 5203 Bonnie Blae Cr., Orlando, FL 32808-2420

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

1. The purpose for which the corporation is organized is as follows: Heaven Sent Women's Outreach Ministries, Inc. is a non-profit agency under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Organized exclusively for charitable and religious and humanitarian purposes, for the rehabilitation of families and individuals, providing food, clothing, shelter, and education, including, but not limited to, any and all lawful business, for the welfare and benefit of said corporation.
2. The making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV MANOR OF ELECTION

Founder Pastor Betty Starling, Principal Director, & Director of Administration and Operations, shall hold any and all authority, voting powers, and keys of said corporation under God.

ARTICLE VIII PROHIBITIONS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for the services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be amended, repealed, or altered in whole or in part by: Pastor Betty Starling, Principal Director, & Director of Administration and Operations.

ARTICLE X MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall be composed of members. The categories of membership, qualifications for membership and the manner of admission shall be set forth in and regulated by the bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XI CORPORATE POWERS § 617.021

The Corporation under the direction of Pastor Betty Starling, Principal Director, & Director of Administration and Operations shall have the power to:

1. Have succession by its corporation name for a perpetual existence.
2. Sue and be sued and appear and defend in all actions and proceedings in its corporate name to the same extent as a natural person.
3. Adopt and use common corporate seal and alter the same; provided, however, that such seal shall always contain the words "corporation not for profit."
4. Elect or appoint such officers and agents as its affairs shall require and allow them reasonable compensation.

5. Adopt, change, amend and repeal bylaws, not inconsistent with law or its articles of incorporation, for the administration of its affairs of the corporation and the exercise of its corporate powers.
6. Increase, by a vote of its members cast as the bylaws may direct, the number of its directors, managers or trustees so that the number shall not be less than three but may be any number in excess thereof.
7. Make contracts and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage and pledge of all or any of its property, franchises or income.
8. Conduct its affairs, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this part in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States or any foreign country.
9. Purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, or otherwise deal in or with real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated.
10. Acquire, enjoy, utilize and dispose of patents, copyrights and trademarks and any licenses and other rights or interests thereunder or therein.
11. Sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer or otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
12. Purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge or otherwise dispose of and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares and other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, whether for profit or not for profit, associations, partnerships or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States, or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district, municipality, or of any instrumentality thereof.
13. Lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
14. Make donations for the public welfare or for religious, charitable, scientific, educational or other similar purposes.
15. Have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized.
16. Merge and consolidate with other corporations both for profit and not for profit, domestic and foreign provided that the surviving corporation is a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE XII TREASURERS

The three treasurers listed below shall have custody of the Operating Account of the Corporation; shall keep a full and accurate account of receipts and expenditures; and shall make disbursements in accordance with the approved budget, as authorized by Pastor Betty Starling Director, & Director of Administration and Operations; and shall be responsible for the maintenance of such books of account and records as to conform to the requirements of the bylaws

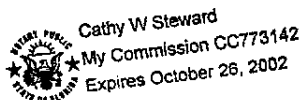
