The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation.

<u>ARTICLE I</u>

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is formed exclusively for educational, literary and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
