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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NEW HORIZONS COUNSELING, Inc.

ARITCLE I. NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be NEW HORIZONS COUNSELING, Inc.

ARTICLE II. AUTHORITY

The corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code.

To receive, administer, disburse and invest gifts, devises and bequest by or from any person or corporation.

To issue bonds, notes, debentures and evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust or otherwise.

This corporation is organized primarily for the purpose of holding the title to such property or properties as the said New Horizons Counseling, Inc., 11103 Mandarin Drive, Clermont, Florida, 34711, is evidenced by resolution of said Board.

To do everything necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment, attainment or furtherance of (and to do every other act or thing incidental to, pertinent to, growing out of or connected with) the purposes, objects or powers set forth in these articles of incorporation, whether alone or in association with others; to possess all the rights, powers, and privileges now or hereafter conferred by law upon a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, and in general, to carry on any activities and to do any of the things herein set forth to the same extent as a natural person or partnership might or could do; provided that nothing herein set forth shall be construed as authorizing the corporation to possess any purpose, object or power to do any act or thing forbidden by the law to a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE VI. MEMBERS

The corporation shall have members. Classifications and qualifications shall be specified in the by-laws.
