ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of IT'S FAVOR INC.

ARTICLE I

CORPORATION NAME

The name of the corporation shall be It's Favor Inc.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE III

CORPORATION PURPOSE

This is a nonprofit corporation, organized the specific and primary purpose of:

A] the advancement of education, enhancement of self esteems and aid to the needy and any other related or corresponding charitable purposes, by providing housing (halfway house) and related programs to assist applicants.

These living arrangements will be made for such purposes pursuant to Florida Not for Profit law Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

B] to operate exclusively in any such charitable and /or educational purposes, as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(C) {3} of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, (or the corresponding provision of any other applicable Internal Revenue Law) as subsequent federal tax law,

covering the distributions to organization qualified as tax exempt organization under the internal revenue code, including private operating foundations.

ARTICLE IV

DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE V

Management of Corporate Affairs

{A} Board of Trustees. The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled and its affairs conducted by a Board of Trustees. The number of Trustees of the corporation shall be at least three (3) and shall not exceed nine (9), provided, however, that such number many be changed by a bylaw duly adopted by the members.

The Trustees named herein as the first Board of Trustees. shall hold office until the first meeting of members at which time an election of Trustees shall be held.

Trustees elected at the first annual meeting, and at until the annual meeting of members following the election office. Annual meetings shall be held at 3720 Westview Avenue West Palm Beach, Fl on the first Monday in May of each year, or designate from time to time by resolution.

Any action required of permitted to be taken by the Board of Trustees under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action, Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as; if taken by unanimous written consent of the Board of Trustee without a meeting, and that the Articles of Incorporation and the By-laws of this corporation authorize the Trustee to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facies evidence of such authority.

ARTICLE VI

EARNING AND ACTIVITIES OF CORPORATION

- (A) No Part of the net earning of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members and trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article IV hereof,
- (B) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (C) Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding Provision; of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- (D) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLES VII

ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ACCEPTANCE

ARTICLE VIII

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the proposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organization organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposed as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Law), not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes of to such organization or organizations as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX

MEMBERSHIP

- (A) The corporation shall have one class of members and no more than one membership may be held by any one person. The rights and privileges of all members shall be equal. Each member shall be entitled to one vote.
- (B) Any person paying dues provided for by the bylaws and agreeing to be bound by the Article of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the corporation and by such rules and regulations as the trustees may from time to time

adopt, is eligible for membership.

(C) A prospective member shall be eligible for membership upon presentation of an approved application by membership committee for approval and acceptance by the Board of Trustee.

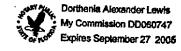
