ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT To ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION Of

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its article of incorporation.

FIRST: The following amendments are to be made:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: (In Spanish): Iglesia Pentecostal Restauración Y Vida Inc. A Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE 2303 Mud Lake Road Plant City, FL 33566

ARTICLE III PURPOSE(S)

We will serve as a missionary church and evangelistic body with a purpose of winning souls to Christ, with out distinction of ethnic or economical background. This ministry is based on the biblical apostolic doctrine and foundation. We will operate as a non-for-profit organization under the article for nonprofit in article 501.C, 3.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The President and the church will elect the initial board of directors. Upon the completion of the initial term, which is a one-year, future board members will be nominated by the president and church. Initial board of directors shall be elected as provided in the incorporation constitution and bylaw as from time to time in existence.
