ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- (1) To disciple and equip believers to maturity and assist each to find his/her place of ministry in the Body of Christ.
- (2) To educate church members and their children, and to construct any necessary facilities to do so.
- (3) To solicit, receive and acquire contributions, tithes, offerings, gifts, legacies, bequests and endowments, consisting of money or property, whether real, personal or mixed.
- (4) To purchase, acquire, own, mortgage, hold, use, invest, sell, dispose of, lease, rent, convey, transfer, pledge, and deed in trust personal or real property; to supervise property of others; to borrow money; to issue bonds, debentures, notes or other obligations of this Corporation or Church from time to time for any of its projects and purposes.
- (5) To engage such employees as may be necessary to perform the duties involved in fulfilling the purposes and functions of this Corporation or Church.
- (6) To have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the Florida Law upon non-profit corporations, as that law is now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.
- (7) To govern itself according to the by-laws adopted for the government of the Corporation and the Church.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION.

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The initial Board of Directors shall be appointed by the Pastor. Any vacancies created thereafter by resignation, voluntary or involuntary removal, or expiration of term of office, shall be filled by election with a majority vote of the office, shall be filled by election with a majority vote of the remaining Board of Directors. Each Director's term of office shall not exceed five (5) years. The Pastor shall be an ex-officio member of resignation, or replacement.
