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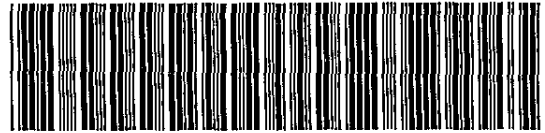

**ARTICLE TWO**




## ARTICLE EIGHT


of the organization is located, exclusive for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


