ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OUTHERN COMFORT HOMEOWNERS: ASSOCIATION

SOUTHERN COMFORT HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

(A NONPROFIT FLORIDA CORPORATION)

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is Southern Comfort Homeowners' Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to act as the governing association of the Southern Comfort, an unrecorded subdivision located at Pensacola, Florida. The principal address of the corporation is 141 Bayshore Drive, Pensacola, Florida, 32507.

ARTICLE III

The qualification of members and the manner of their admission shall be as follows: Any approved person or persons who hold title in fee simple to a home in the Subdivision shall by virtue of such ownership be a member of this corporation. Provided however, that transfer of membership shall be made only as a part of and incident to the transfer of ownership of a home with such transfers being subject to and controlled by the transfer procedures set forth in the By-Laws. After receiving approval of the Association required by the By-Laws, change of membership in the Association shall be established by recording in the Public Records of Escambia County, Florida, a deed or other instrument establishing record title to a home in the Subdivision and the delivery of a copy of the recorded instrument to the Association within a reasonable time following such recordation. Such delivery is not required for initial conveyances by the Developer. The owner designated by such instrument thereby becomes a member of the Association and the membership of the previous owner is thereby terminated.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V

The name and residence of the Incorporator is as follows:

The rights and interests of the incorporators shall automatically terminate when these Articles are filed with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the corporation are to be managed initially by a Board of three Directors (which may be expanded to eleven) who will be appointed by the Developer as provided for in the By-Laws. Subsequent Boards may be composed of either three, five, seven, nine, or eleven Directors.

ARTICLE VII

The names of the Officers who are to serve until the first election of appointment under the Articles of Incorporation are:

ARTICLE VIII

The number of persons constituting the first Board of Directors shall be three, and their names and addresses are as follows:

ARTICLE IX

After turnover, the By-Laws of the corporation may be made, amended or rescinded by twothirds of the voting interests of the corporation; prior to turnover, by a majority of the Directors alone.

ARTICLE X

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed and adopted as follows:

After turnover, an Amendment may be proposed by either the Board of Directors or by Twenty-Five Percent (25%) of the voting interests and may be considered at any meeting of the owners, regular or special, of which due notice has been given according to the By-Laws, which includes a notice of the substance of the proposed Amendment; prior to turnover by a majority of the Directors alone.

After turnover, the Amendment must be approved by a vote of two-thirds of the voting interests of the corporation; prior to turnover, by the Directors alone.

ARTICLE XI

Each owner in the Subdivision shall have one full indivisible vote. The term "Owner" shall be defined in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE XII

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE XIII

This corporation shall have all the powers permitted by law together with such additional specific powers as are contained in the Declaration and By-Laws.

ARTICLE XIV

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member of individual, except through the acquisition, construction, management, maintenance or care of Association property or through the rebate of the excess membership dues, fees or assessments.

ARTICLE XV

The name of the resident agent and place for service of process shall be Kathleen Jones, whose address is: 141 Bayshore Drive, Pensacola, Florida, 32507.
