ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF.

THE MONTESSORI CHILDREN'S HOUSE OF HYDE PARK SCHOLARSHIP FUND, INC.

EUNE LIRY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

I, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for charitable and philanthropic purposes under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I. Name and Principal Office

The name of this corporation shall be The Montessori Children's House of Hyde Park Scholarship Fund, Inc., and it shall have a principal address of 201 South Armenia Avenue, Tampa, Florida 33606.

Article II. Term of Existence

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing on the date these Articles are filed with the Florida Secretary of State.

Article III. Purpose

This corporation is formed exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as that section may from time to time be amended, and, to that end, to do the following:

- Raise and provide financial aid and scholarships to students attending The Montessori Children's House of Hyde Park.
- To do any and all lawful acts and things, alone or in cooperation with other persons or organizations, which may be necessary, useful, suitable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, or attainment of any or all of the purposes or powers of the corporation.

Article IV. Powers

Subject to the provisions of Article III, this corporation shall have all powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon not for profit corporations.

Article V. Membership

This corporation shall have no members.

Article VI. Registered Office and Registered Agent

The initial registered agent, and the street address of the initial registered office, shall be Alfred A. Colby, 101 East Kennedy Boulevard, Suite 3140, Tampa, Florida 33602.

VII. Board of Directors

Section 1. The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. This corporation shall initially have three (3) directors. The directors shall be elected as provided in this corporation's Bylaws.

Section 2. The names and addresses of the persons who shall serve as initial directors are as follows:

Section 3. The term of service of each director shall be as set forth in the corporation's Bylaws.

Section 4. The number of directors maybe changed from time to time, by amendment to the Bylaws, but shall never be fewer than three.

Article VIII. Bylaws

Section 1. The power to adopt Bylaws for this corporation, to alter, amend, or repeal said Bylaws, and to adopt new Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors of this corporation.

Section 2. The Bylaws of this corporation shall be for the government of the corporation and may contain any provisions or requirements for the management or conduct of the affairs and business of the corporation, provided that the Bylaws are not inconsistent with the provisions

of these Articles of Incorporation or contrary to the laws of the State of Florida or of the United States.

Article IX. Incorporator

Article X. Use of Income

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, officer, director, or other private individual (except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the corporation and reimburse individuals for reasonable expenses incurred for the benefit of the corporation), and no member, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

Article XI. Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision in these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as that Section may from time to time be amended.

Article XII. Dissolution

Upon dissolution of this corporation, all of its assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or as that Section may from time to time be amended, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, officer, or director of this corporation.

Article XIII. Non-Stock Basis

This corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis.
