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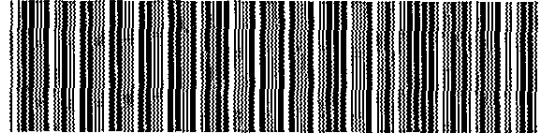

TO THE HONORABLE JAMES T. PERKINS, AS THE JUDGE OF THE SEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA, IN AND FOR ORANGE COUNTY:

Your petitioners respectfully petitioning show unto your Honor that they have agreed upon the original articles of a proposed incorporation not for profit, as hereto attached; that they have subscribed said proposed Charter in accordance with law, each of your petitioners signing his own name as next thereunto appears; that one of your petitioners has made and subscribed the oath endorsed on said proposed Charter before an officer authorized to take acknowledgments of deeds and said officer has duly certified, signed and sealed the same as fully appears thereon; that it is intended in good faith to carry out the purposes and objects set forth therein; that the notice of the intent to make the application formulated according to law has been duly furnished a newspaper for publication; and that in due course, to-wit: on the 29th day of December A. D. , 1914, your petitioners shall present said proposed Charter with due proof of publication to your Honor. And your petitioners pray that your Honor may find that the law has in all respects been complied with and that your Honor may approve said Charter and endorse the approval of the Court thereon.

## PROPOSED CHARTER

OF

## OAKLAND CEMETERY ASSOCIATION.

We, the undersigned citizens of the County of Orange and State of Florida desiring to form a corporation not for profit and to become incorporated as such in the manner prescribed by law, have associated ourselves together under the following proposed Charter:

1. The name of the corporation shall be OAKLAND CEMETERY ASSOCIATION.
2. The purpose of the corporation, or association, shall be to provide suitable and adequate burial grounds for its members and their families, and to this end may buy, own, and mortgage real estate, and may sell and convey the same in such manner as shall be provided in the By-laws.
3. Membership in the corporation, or association, may be acquired by any white person upon the signing of the By-laws and an agreement to be governed by the same; and shall pay to the association such sum or sums of money for lot or lots in the cemetery as shall be fixed by the Board of Directors.
4. The term for which the said corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.
5. The names of the members of this corporation, or association, are as follows:

and such other persons as may hereafter become members in accordance with the By-laws.

6. The affairs or business of the corporation, or association, shall be conducted by a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and one other member, who shall constitute a Board of Directors, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum to transact any business of the corporation. The Board of Directors herein provided for shall be elected by members of the corporation at an annual meeting to be held on the first Monday after the first Tuesday in June of each year, beginning June 1915, in accordance with the By-laws. And the officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors.

7. Until the first annual meeting to be called on the first Monday after the first Tuesday in June, 1915, the business of the corporation shall be conducted by the following officers: S. B. Hull, President; W. T. Hickman, Vice President; J. E. Petris, Secretary; and G. T. Smith, Treasurer; and C. H. Tilden, from the body of the members.

8. The By-laws of the corporation, or association, shall be made, altered or rescinded by the Board of Directors subject to the approval of the members present at any annual meeting of the members of the corporation.

9. This corporation, or association, shall not be subject to any amount of indebtedness.

10. The amount of real estate <sup>held</sup> by the corporation, or association, shall not exceed forty acres, and shall not exceed in value Fifty Dollars per acre.
