
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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

A NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARITCLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Palm Beach Yacht & Sporting Museum, Inc.

<u>ARTICLE II – DURATION</u>

The corporation shall begin its existence on December 20, 2002, and shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be 50 Cocoanut Row, Palm Beach, Florida 33480, and the mailing address of the corporation shall be P.O. Box 2695, Palm Beach, Florida 33480.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSES

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- A. To own and operate as a floating museum the oldest documented large wooden motor yacht in America, namely the 70 Foot Mathis Trumpy named "Ibis" built in Camden, New Jersey in 1912.
- B. To educate students at all levels on American maritime history, and/or on skills of construction, repair and maintenance of historic seaworthy yachts, and/or the preservation of the marine environment and/or on the methods and manners of operating a passenger yacht for short term outings and long term cruises to obtain charitable donations.
- C. To educate students at all levels of the historic significance and environmental importance of historical motor vehicles.
- D. To develop curriculum in the abovesaid yacht and motor vehicle education for all interested persons.

- E. To perform all acts necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes set forth in A, B, C and D above, including all types of fund raising events.
- F. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, and/or educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V - ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation to be adopted by the Incorporator of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP

The manner in which persons shall become members of the corporation shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII - LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

No Part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII - INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The name of the initial registered agent is Reid Moore, Jr., and the street address of the initial registered office is 50 Cocoanut Row, Palm Beach, Florida 33480.

ARTICLE IX - DISTRIBTUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

The assets of the corporation upon dissolution of the corporation shall be transferred for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE X - INCORPORATOR

The name and street address of the Incorporator for these Articles of Incorporation are Reid Moore, Jr. and 50 Cocoanut Row, Palm Beach, Florida 33480.


