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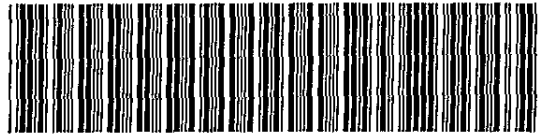

**IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED THAT:**

- 1) The name of the corporation is: Viki Parkes Stars of Tomorrow Inc.

- 2) The corporation is a corporation as defined in 90-172  
of section 14 (Definitions) of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.
- 3) The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed is as  
follows:

THE CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AS  
EXPRESSED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954.

TO PROVIDE A MEANS WHEREBY YOUNG AND MIDDLE AGED CHILDREN MAY BE TAUGHT, INSTRUCTED  
AND INFORMED ABOUT ALL ASPECTS OF DANCE TECHNIQUES.

The corporation, in furtherance of its corporate purposes above, shall  
have all the powers in section 90-172 of the Not-for-Profit Corporate Law,  
subject to any limitations provided in the Not-for-Profit Corporate Law  
or any other statute of the State of Florida. Nothing herein shall  
authorize this corporation, directly or indirectly, to engage in, or  
include among its purposes, any of the activities mentioned in the Not-  
for-Profit Corporation Law.

- 7) State and Federal exemption.

State and Federal exemption language for Florida corporations seeking tax exemption:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under IRC section 501(c)(3) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation) and no member, trustee, officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by IRC section 501(h) or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidates for public office.

In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall, after necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to another organization exempt under IRC section 501(c)(3), or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws, or to the Federal government, or state or local government for a public purpose, subject to the approval of a Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of New York.

In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as described in IRC section 509(a), the corporation shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under IRC section 4942 and the corporation shall not: a) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in IRC section 4941(d), retain any excess business holdings as defined in IRC section 4943(c), b) make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under IRC section 4944, or c) make any taxable expenditures as defined in IRC section 4945(d) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

In the event that the corporation is a school as described in IRC section 501(c)(3), the school will admit students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to the rights, privileges and activities generally accorded to all students. The school will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its education policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs and athletic and other school-administered programs.
